

## Bedside Trays and Larger Holders

Cut 1-7" square for outside fabric
Cut 1-7" square for lining fabric
Cut 1-7" square for wadding
A 7" square will make a nice size tray although for the larger holders you will need to add the base size with side height to give the size of the square to cut. For example if the base required is $12^{\prime \prime}$ and the sides are to be $3^{\prime \prime}$ in height, a 18 "square needs to be cut.

1. Once you have cut the fabric to the required size, lay the lining and outside fabric with the right sides facing. Place the wadding on top

2. Stitch around the edge approx $1 / 4$ " leaving a gap to enable you to turn the tray

3. Make sure that the corners are turned out fully. Stitch again around the edge approx $1 / 4$ in or narrower if you can manage this. It will neaten the turning whole nicely.

4. Measure $1^{\prime \prime}$ in from the outside edge and stitch the square shape again. This forms the base.

5. Fold the stitched square in half to form a triangle. At each corner stitch a straight line across. Repeat until the four corners have been stitched in place.
